1. The Chairman opened the meeting and passed round an English translation of a letter from Senor Correas regarding the setting up of 'Community of Owners' as required by the 'Laws of Horizontal Property' This aroused many comments from the members a number stating that they had taken legal advise and it is their understanding that they do not have to have a Community of Owners. One of the comments from the floor slatted that the Town Hall wanted a lot from the Urbanizations and gave very little in return. It was agreed that in order to clarify this situation is to ask the Mayor to hold a meeting between all the represented Urbanizations and the Mayor and Councillors, Hernandez, Correas and a Solicitor.
2. Councillor Inma Hernandez then arrived with David Hardy.
3. On the subject of potable water Councillor Hernandez explained that there was a legal document being prepared by the Town Hall secretary as well as the technical document that councillor Correas was preparing. She also under took to get the Mayor to explain the current situation as Senor Correas had given two dates for the Mayor announcement which had come and gone with no explanation
4. The Chairman stated that in the last 8 weeks only one topic had been addressed from the list submitted to the Town Hall and that was the visit by the Chief of Police Local and Senor Ballester to discuss the traffic signs in Las Filipinas This happened in the last few days.

5. The Town Hall insists that they want us to integrate but they appear to show us a total lack of respect. [PMN I](#) have discussed this with a Spanish friend and he says it is not a lack of respect but a cultural difference. Possibly stemming back over the last 50/60 years where no one told anyone anything. We are trying to change something in a couple years that could possibly take a life time.
6. Councillor Hernandez listened to us going the various items requiring Town Hall and agreed put the items before the Mayor and Councillor Correas, the items Were: -
 - a. Lack of bottle Collection Banks on Aldea del Monte.
 - b. Clean up after your dog signs for all Urbanizations
 - c. Discuss removing rubbish from Villa Maria 2
 - d. Lights on service road to La Canada
 - e. Set up seminar regarding i. Documentation required in Spain ii. SIP cards.
7. Mike Levy asked if the classification of land in Las Filipinas could be discussed at the next Town Hall meeting.
8. The Chairman thanked Councillor Hernandez for coming to the meeting.
